Thomas William Tweed was born in Medicine Hat, Alberta. Educated at the University of Manitoba, he began his radio career as a free-lance actor and writer in Winnipeg, Manitoba. In 1941 Tommy Tweed moved to Toronto, Ontario, where he was a regular contributor of original scripts and adaptations to C.B.C. radio. His acting career was primarily in radio but he also performed in stage, television and motion picture productions. A keen amateur historian, Tweed researched little known but colourful figures in Canadian history and several of his writings reflect this interest.

Presented in 1972 and 1973 by Mrs. J.W. Tweed of Toronto, Ont. Sketches, photographs, banners, decorations and a plan have been transferred to the appropriate divisions, a certificate has been placed in a vertical filing cabinet.
