The papers in this collection relate wholly to James Duncan Graham(1799-1865), a topographical engineer with the United States Army. Commissioned a major in the Corps of Topographical Engineers in 1838, Graham's catreer included survey assignments along the Texas-American and British North American-American frontier. It was during an assignment on the Great Lakes that Graham discovered the existence of a lunar tide (1858-1859). Breveted a lieutenant-colonel in 1861, he was accorded the same rank in the newly formed corps of Engineers in 1863.

The finding aid is a chronological list of items found in the Graham Papers.
