The correspondence of James Poole, editor of the Carleton Place HERALD, was removed from a set of office copies of the weekly newspaper for 1856-1865 (now in the National Library). The correspondence has been retained in the order of the issues to which it refers. This finding aid comprises solely a list of issue numbers and dates, and the page numbers of the relevant correspondence. Many of the items are fragmentary: notes, drafts of advertisements, accounts, minutes of township or agricultural society meetings, etc. There is no material for 1860 or 1863.
