Originals, 1956-1973, 66 feet, 3 inches.

The Canadian Theatre Centre was founded in 1958 and received its Letters Patent in 1959. It was established as a national association of professional theatre groups, organizations and individuals who combined to assist the promotion and development of professional and educational theatre in Canada. The Canadian Theatre Centre was also the Canadian representative of the International Theatre Institute, an organization sponsored by UNESCO. The CTC ceased to exist in 1973.

Administration, 1959-1973 (Vols. 1-5) 2 feet, 9 inches: Includes constitution and structure; board of directors; executive committee; executive committee and board of directors; board of governors; annual meetings; reports; committees; individual officer's files; applications for post of secretary general. All files are arranged chronologically except individual officer's files which are arranged alphabetically. Access restricted to applications for post of secretary general (Vol. 5).

Finances, 1959-1973 (Vols. 6-21) 9 feet, 10 inches: Includes financial statements and budgets; subsidies and grants; financial records. All files arranged chronologically except 'account cards', a sub-series of financial records, which are arranged alphabetically.

Membership, 1959-1973 (Vols. 22-41) 12 feet, 11 inches: Includes membership correspondence; complimentary memberships; form letters; membership lists and reports; membership information; individual membership; group membership; university membership; membership records and receipts. All files arranged chronologically except individual, group and university membership files which are arranged alphabetically.

Publications, 1962-1973 (Vols. 41-53) 8 feet, 5 inches: Includes CTC Bulletin - Scène Canada Stage; miscellaneous CTC publications; information files for CTC publishing; sale of non-CTC publications by CTC.

CTC Bulletin - Scène Canada Stage consists of finances, receipts, subscriber record cards, distribution, content, general and miscellaneous correspondence, miscellaneous files and issues of Scène Canada Stage. All files are arranged chronologically except subscriber record cards and the content sub-series 'individual author and article files' which are arranged alphabetically.

Miscellaneous CTC Publications include bibliographies, Directory of Membership, Performing Arts Directory, Playwrights Directory, Lexicon, Premières Canada, Theatre Yearbook and Useful Addresses. Files are arranged chronologically with any issues appearing at the end of each sub-series

Information Files for CTC publishing and sale of non-CTC publications by CTC are arranged chronologically.

Surveys, 1959-1971 (Vols. 54-59) 3 feet, 9 inches: Includes theatre facilities survey and miscellaneous surveys.

Theatre Facilities Survey consists of financial records, general correspondence and supplement to survey, all of which are arranged chronologically; and Atlantic Provinces, Quebec, Ontario and Western Provinces which are arranged alphabetically according to towns and cities in each province.

Miscellaneous Surveys are arranged alphabetically.

Collections and Exhibitions, 1958-1972 (Vols. 59-61) 1 foot, 4 inches:
Includes poster displays; library, archives and exhibitions;
publications in library. All files arranged chronologically
except poster displays sub-series 'composition and distribution'
files which are arranged according to numbers assigned to the
poster displays by CTC, and publications in library which are
arranged alphabetically.

Playreading and Playwrights, 1959-1972 (Vols. 61-67) 4 feet, 2 inches:
Includes playreading; script library; playwriting in general.

Playreading consists of correspondence which is arranged geogra-
phically according to province and alphabetically according to
play and chronologically if general; and script reports which are
arranged alphabetically according to play.

Script Library consists of correspondence which is arranged
alphabetically according to play and chronologically if general;
and scripts which are arranged alphabetically according to title.

Playwriting in General files arranged chronologically.

Employment Programs and Information, 1960-1972 (Vols. 67-71) 2 feet
6 inches: Includes management training programmes; technical
apprentice programme; auditions; job opportunities; inquiries and
information re: employment. All files arranged chronologically
except job opportunities which are arranged alphabetically. Access
restricted to some management training programme, all technical
apprentice programme and auditions files (Vols. 68-70).

Subject Files: Organizations, 1956-1973 (Vols. 71-84) 8 feet, 8 inches:
Includes Canada Council; Canadian Conference of The Arts;
International Theatre Institute; UNESCO; other organizations.

International Theatre Institute consists of correspondence,
memoranda and reports; world theatre day; publications.

All files arranged chronologically except other organizations
which are arranged alphabetically.

Subject Files: Conferences, Seminars and Festivals, 1962-1972 (Vols.
84-96) 8 feet: Includes Colloquim '67 and other conferences,
seminars and festivals.

Colloquim '67 consists of general and individual files which
are arranged alphabetically, and colloquim proceedings and
colloquim '67 publication files which are arranged chronologically.

Other conferences, seminars and festivals arranged alphabetically.

Miscellaneous Subject Files, (Vols. 96-97) 8 inches: Arranged
alphabetically.

General Office Files, 1957-1972, (Vols. 97-99) 1 foot, 3 inches:
Includes insurance; taxes; translations; travel; miscellaneous;
personnel. All files arranged alphabetically except personnel
general files which are arranged chronologically.

Correspondence, 1959-1973, (Vols. 99-101) 1 foot, 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches: Includes
general correspondence; foreign contacts; public relations.
Arranged chronologically.

Clippings, 1965-1971, (Vol. 101) $\frac{1}{4}$ inch: Arranged chronologically.

Tom Henry - MSS. and Related Correspondence 1965-1968, (Vol. 102)
4 inches: Arranged chronologically.
