BIOGRAPHY

The Women's Liberal Federation of Canada was established at the First National Assembly of Liberal Women, held in Ottawa in 1928, as was the youth branch, the Twentieth Century Liberal Association.

At the founding Convention, the women's federation had only two provincial associations, Ontario and Nova Scotia. They opened their national office in Ottawa and continued to direct their activities from there, while increasing their provincial affiliations until September 1939.

Both the National Liberal Federation and the Women's Federation closed during the second world war. They opened again before the federal election of 1945 and a National Women's Convention was held in 1947. Shortly after this the "Liberal Woman" was published serving as a monthly information medium for the women's clubs.

Prince Edward Island became nationally affiliated in 1948 and Newfoundland followed in 1949. The federation was truly national in representation at this time. The Federation continued as an active and vital component of the Liberal Federation until November 1970, when at their National Convention the vote for integration was carried and the Women's Federation as such, was dissolved.

PROVENANCE

The papers were donated to the Public Archives of Canada in 1975 by the Women's Federation Headquarters, Ottawa. Photographs have been transferred to the National Photographic Collection. Posters will be found in the vertical file cabinets, Manuscript Division.

Finding Aid No. 6553 is a subject file list. The papers are arranged in eight (8) series:

NATIONAL EXECUTIVE, 1928-1970.

Files, created by and for the use of members of the Women's National Executive, are arranged by executive positions in chronological order.

NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEES, 1944-1970.

Files created by the various women's executive committees, containing correspondence, memoranda, etc. and are arranged alphabetically.

NATIONAL EXECUTIVE MEETINGS AND CONVENTIONS, 1930-1970.
Contains correspondence, memoranda, reports, etc., regarding preparations for and records of proceedings of meetings, etc. Arranged chronologically.

NATIONAL LIBERAL PARTY OF CANADA, 1948-1973.

Consists of records of proceedings of meetings and conventions, arranged chronologically. Also included are subject files concerning the National Liberal Party, arranged alphabetically.

CONSTITUENCY RECORDS, 1941-1970.

Contains files on the provincial organizations, and constituency clubs. Arranged alphabetically.

GENERAL ELECTIONS, 1953-1968.

Consists of riding lists, pamphlets, Liberal candidates listings, questionnaires, campaign material, correspondence, memoranda, clippings, notes and comments created and/orgused by the Women's Headquarter during federal elections. Arranged chronologically.

REFERENCE, 1930-1969,

Consists of subject files. Arranged alphabetically.

OVERSIZE, 1959-1968.

Consists of samples of campaign material and a scrapbook.
