The Canadian Chamber of Commerce came into existence after a conference held in Winnipeg in 1925. Given the provisional name of Canadian Board of Trade, the Chamber later adopted its present name. The first annual meeting was held in 1926; a Board of Directors was elected, a set of by-laws agreed upon and its was decided to appoint a General Secretary with headquarters in Montreal. Initially, the Chamber received all of its revenue from the large member Boards and Chambers. More recently it has derived most of its funds from member business firms.

The Chamber has been a prominent pressure group, lobbying governments on a wide range of issues of interest to the business community. These have included taxation, levels of government expenditure and labour relations. In addition, the Chamber maintained a very active Canada-United States Committee.

The organization is affiliated with the various provincial chambers of Commerce. It now focusses mainly on national issues, while the local and provincial chambers and Boards of Trade deal with matters pertaining to their jurisdiction.

For many years the Chamber published a glossy periodical entitled Canadian Business, as well as member publications, the Newsletter and The Record.

The collection was presented in 1976 by the Canadian Chamber of Commerce, Montreal. Published items have been transferred to the Public Archives Library, photographs to the National Photo Collection and a sound recording to National Film, Sound and Television Archives (accession number 1981-46).

The finding aid No. 1269 consists of an item-by-item list of the Reports (vols. 77-78) and the Speeches (vols. 79-80) and a file list to the rest of the collection.

Board of Directors Minutes, 1934-1951, 1954-1968. 42 cm (volumes 5-7). This series includes nominal lists of directors.

Annual Reports, 1941-1943, 1946-1969. 4 cm (volume 5).

Annual Meeting Files, 1925-1974. 6.39 m (volumes 1-5, 20-47). This series consists of addresses, minutes of business sessions and chronological subject files.

Committee Minutes, 1932-1969. 1.72 m (volumes 8-16).

Arranged alphabetically. Included are minutes of the Executive Committee, 1934-1949 and Council, 1949-1969.

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Committee Files, 1947-1970. 2.55 m (volumes 47-59). Arranged alphabetically.

Subject Files, 1923-1971. 3.6 m (volumes 17-18, 60-73,77-80). Policy declarations, files relating to the Executive Council and the International Labour Organization, reports, serial letters and speeches, alphabetical series on various subjects (volumes 61-62).

Printed Material, 1925-1975. 1.28 m (volumes 16-17, 18-19, 73-76). Scrapbooks, periodicals, newspaper clippings and pamphlets. Surveys prepared for the Chamber on public attitudes toward business and on high school students.
