IMPERIAL ORDER DAUGHTERS OF THE EMPIRE (est. 1900) (National Chapter) (page 1)

Founded by Margaret Polson Murray of Montreal in 1900 as The Federation of The Daughers of the British Empire, and the Children of the Empire (Juvenile Branch), the Order moved its headquarters to Toronto in 1901 and became incorporated in Ontario under the name The Imperial Order Daughters of the Empire, and The Children of the Empire. Its expressed objectives included the stimulation of patriotic sentiment, the fostering of a bond of union among women and children throughout the Empire, the promotion of study of the Empire, care for the dependents of military personnel, and the preservation of the memory of brave and historic deeds. Chapters were organized throughout Canada and in 1917 Dominion incorporation was obtained. The organization of a proposed Imperial Chapter was never achieved, although the Order did succeed in establishing chapters in Bermuda, the Bahamas, India, and the United States, and entered into affiliation with a number of like-minded associations elsewhere in the Empire.

One of the Order's first major projects entailed the location and marking of graves of those who died in the South African War, and during both World Wars the I.O.D.E. performed considerable work in raising funds and providing comforts for service personnel. Yet, from its inception, the Order has also been closely involved in the promotion of education, health, and welfare, assisting in the construction and maintenance of medical facilities, providing financial aid to students, encouraging the study of the history and current concerns of both Canada and the Commonwealth, and promoting good citizenship.

Twenty-six pages of I.O.D.E. material was acquired previously by the PAC. The remainder of the collection was presented in 1979 by the I.O.D.E. National Chapter through Mrs. Peter Douglas, I.O.D.E. President. The former accession has been integrated into the latter.

A large number of photographs have been transferred to the National Photography Collection.

Three reels of film have been sent to Film Archives and two sound recordings to Sound Archives.

Posters and pictures have been transferred to the Picture Division and a number of pins and medals to the National Medal Collection. One architectural drawing has been sent to the National Map Collection. Various books on Canada have been transferred to the Public Archives Library as have issues of the Order's magazine Echoes. Sample charters of four chapters - Coronation (Vancouver), Trafalgar (London), Strathcona (Toronto), Elizabeth (Toronto) - have been placed in the vertical file cabinet in the Manuscript Division.

Phetocopies of applications for charters from chapters in Bermuda, the Bahamas, and Canada, 1900-1979 (volumes 17-18).

Included are copies of correspondence concerning certain individual applications. Applications from Canadian chapters are arranged alphabetically by province and by community within each province.

Original charters (volumes 70-75) and microfilm copy (reel H-1015). Charters are arranged alphabetically by province and by community within each province and chronologically within community (except oversize originals which are found in volume 75). Four sample charters are available in the vertical file cabinet in the Manuscript Division.

Included are three pamphlets outlining the history and work of the I.O.D.E. plus miscellaneous historical sketches and notes.

Miscellaneous Correspondence, n.d., 1900-1972. Originals, 20 cm (volume 20).

Most of the correspondence dates from the formative years of the Order and involves such matters as organizing (both in Canada and overseas) and membership, local chapter activities, business relations, I.O.D.E. projects and interests, and the activities of and relations with the Order's non-Canadian affiliates including the Guild of Loyal Women of South Africa, the Victoria League, and the League of Empire. Arranged chronologically.

Miscellaneous Subject Files, n.d., 1901-1977. Originals and photocopies, 1.6 m (volumes 21-28).

Correspondence, memoranda and notes, reports, clippings, and some committee minutes covering a wide range of I.O.D.E. activities and projects. Included are files on such topics as: South African War graves; I.O.D.E. work in India; I.O.D.E. activities during both world wars; the war memorial scholarship fund; Commonwealth and international relations; social projects; the Order's position on a number of national issues; and internal matters. Arranged by subject.

Chapter Records, n.d., 1900-1974. Originals and photocopies, 60 cm (volumes 29-31).

Correspondence, memoranda, notes, reports, pamphlets. This series of records of provincial, municipal and primary chapters has been divided into two sub-series, viz: records created by and/or relating strictly to provincial, municipal and primary chapters and their activities; and those files pertaining to projects and activities which, although involving primarily single chapters, had wider regional or national significance. Files are arranged by Province within each sub-series.

Miscellaneous Printed Material, n.d., 1900-1979. Originals, 52 cm (volumes 32-35).

Reports, pamphlets, souvenirs, magazines, press clippings, miscellaneous memorabilia, newspapers. The series is divided into two sub-series, viz: non-I.O.D.E. material (volumes 32 and 35) and material printed by or about the I.O.D.E. or its activities (volumes 33-35).

#### Note on the Organization of the Papers:

The National Chapter of Canada organized the bulk of its material according to subject, and where possible, this system of order has been maintained. However, the researcher should note the following points which will assist in cross-referencing material from the different sub-sections of the collection:

Minutes - National Committees: For correspondence, memoranda, etc. concerning the activities of certain of these committees, the researcher is directed to the Subject Files.

Constitution, Structure and History: The historical pamphlets and sketches found here are general in nature and relate to National I.O.D.E. interests. For material relating to the specific history of individual chapters or particular issues, consult the Subject Files, Chapter Records, or Scrapbooks.

<u>Chapter Records:</u> Minute books and scrapbooks for individual chapters will be found in the Minutes-Miscellaneous, and Scrapbooks sections.

Echoes: This I.O.D.E. publication is a particularly good source of information for both I.O.D.E. organization and chapter activities and the broader national and international concerns of the Order. A fairly complete run of the magazine from February 1902 to 1946 and miscellaneous issues, 1963-1979, have been transferred to the PAC Library along with an index covering the years 1934-1975. This index will also be found in Volume 33.

<u>Charters</u> (Originals): Owing to the irregular size of some of the charters, they do not appear in the same order in Volumes 70-75 as they do on microfilm Reel H-1015. Oversize charters have all been placed in Volume 75. The remainder are arranged alphabetically by province, alphabetically by province, alphabetically by community within each province and chronologically within communities.
