MacGillivray Album 1984-180

The MacGillivray Album is a carte-de-visite album bounded with a hard leather (?) cover with two metal clasps. The album consists of 50 folios whereby three of the fifty carte-de-visites are unfortunately missing. While the owner of the album remains a mystery, it most likely belonged to one of the Macgillivrays as the majority of the identified portraits are the descendants of John and Isabella Macgillivray. In addition to the family portraits, some of the family strends and acquaristances have also been included.
