

Finding Aid for 1968-067:

A basic finding aid for Meredith's series on historic buildings is located in box 2000775634. It contains Meredith's original numbering system and the National Archive's corresponding copy/PA numbers. It is also an index to his collection of photographs on historic buildings in Southern Ontario, and breaks down the series by building type, town/location, date erected, and past and current owners.

Meredith was hired by the Dominion Parks Branch in the summer of 1925 to photograph historic buildings in Southern Ontario [for Parks Branch documentation and correspondence with Meredith, see the National Archives' National Parks Branch Manuscript Group RG-84, Microfilm Reel T-14267, titled "Old Buildings", in file HS56 part 1, Series A-2-A, Volume 1442].

The following six boxes contain photographic images that are related to the project:

Box 2000775634: Contains finding aid mentioned above, Album 1, including photographs of churches of a number of denominations across Southern Ontario and corresponding information cards that provide some historic details of each building (ie. Date erected, building materials).

Box 2000775635: Album 2, including photographs and information cards of ruins, shops, houses, farm houses and mills.

Box 2000775636: Album 3, including photographs and information cards of farm houses and houses built of various materials.

Box 2000761280: ca. 610 loose prints of duplicate or triplicate copies of those photographs found in the albums above (churches, houses, mills, ruins and shops).

Box 2000775634: Corresponding nitrate negatives to almost all of the prints mentioned above.
