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CANADIAN ENGINEERING HERITAGE RECORD (est. 1972)

The Canadian Engineering Heritage Record (CEHR) was set up in 1972 as a joint project by the Engineering Institute of Canada (EIC) and the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (IAND), the federal ministry responsible for national historic sites. The Record was to identify and create an inventory of engineering and technological achievements which have contributed to the development of Canada, with the aim of "providing a permanent record of the tangible remains of Canada's engineering, technological and industrial heritage, and bringing to the attention of the responsible authorities those items which may warrant commemoration or preservation". One catalogue of significant sites, structures and artifacts was produced in 1974. The recording was done largely by volunteers, and the resulting data, never verified, should be used with caution.

In 1974, the EIC recommended expanding the project to include other professional or trade groups. The result was the inclusion of the Canadian Council of Professional Engineers. Further proposals suggested that the CEHR be taken over and administered solely by IAND with advisors from professional associations, in a manner similar to the Canadian Inventory of Historic Building. No further action was taken, however, and the project, which had begun to falter, fell inactive around 1977.

Research files, general, n.d., 1961-1976. 25 cm (volumes 1 and 14).

Reports, articles and other research material concerning topics in engineering history which are not associated with particular geographical locations. Subjects include the Canadian brick industry, electric power development, elevators, Frederick Newton Gisborne and Sir William Logan. A CEHR catalogue is also included.

Research reports, n.d., 1920-1979. 1.4 m (volumes 2-8).

Reports, mostly produced for the CEHR from 1972-1979, on structures or artifacts deemed to be a significant part of Canada's engineering heritage. Most of the reports are brief, primarily consisting of descriptions of the objects; frequently photographs and blueprints are included. Many of the files contain supporting research material. The bulk of the reports concern sites in Ontario, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, but all provinces and territories except Prince Edward Island are represented. Arranged alphabetically by location with each province.

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Administration, n.d., 1959, 1970-1978. 50 cm (volumes 9-11).

Memoranda of agreement, minutes of CEHR national committee and EIC committees, correspondence, directives and communiqués from IAND, budget reports, project lists and site index cards, records of volunteer and contracted surveyors, project proposals, publicity files, and various other subject files.

Reference files, n.d., 1951-1977. 67 cm (volumes 12-15).

Contains guidelines, proposals and survey report forms for recording information, in draft and printed form, as well as status reports for the project. Also reference sources such as bibliographies, glossaries and articles; and material pertaining to general historic preservation and recording in Canada, Britain, the United States and various other countries. This material, from both government agencies and private historical societies, includes correspondence, reports, photocopied articles and publications. A file cabinet contains index cards with the file classification code, bibliographies, resource addresses, and Hamilton inventory entries. Most of the material is from 1970-1977.
