EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Dr. Oscar Peterson has been celebrated over the years by writers, critics, dignitaries and jazz enthusiasts alike. His acclaim as a pianistic genius, innovator, educator and prominent Canadian are uncontestable. But though the hyperbole may seem exhaustive, much remains to be said about this great man. He has been awarded innumerable music prizes, honourary doctorates and holds the Order of Canada companion medal and countless other citations from around the world. He is recognized as the unofficial Ambassador of Goodwill for Canada. In international circles he is compared in stature and genius with Glenn Gould, highlighting his immeasurable contribution to Canadian music.

He has made his mark in the annals of jazz music as one of the best pianists in history. His unmistakable style, technical virtuosity and brilliant musicality have made his name synonymous with true innovation in jazz piano. Dr. Peterson's blistering piano style was enhanced by an extraordinary technique involving dynamic use of both hands. In a recent article in the Globe and Mail, a reviewer commented that he played piano better with one hand (a stroke has diminished the use of his left hand) than most people play with two.

Dr. Peterson's unwavering commitment to Canada has enabled him to prove that international artistic success does not depend on leaving home. His pride in being Canadian ensured that he became known as a truly Canadian artist. He has also been a vocal advocate for social and racial integration, even prior to the advent of multiculturalism. His accomplishments in these areas provide other aspiring Canadians with living proof that one's convictions can be a powerful force for change.

This archival collection of video, audio and printed material is a unique compilation as it brings into focus the most important elements of Oscar Peterson's life--his music, family, colleagues, and his place in history. The body of material includes over 30 interviews, three live concerts, behind the scene video footage and photos and memorabilia. The interviews with notable musicians and writers such as Maureen Forrester, Quincy Jones, Ella Fitzgerald, Dizzie Gillespie, Cleo Laine & John Dankworth, and John Gilmore chronicle the public and professional life of this artist. They draw out the impact of his accomplishments within the context of jazz music and history. The intimate personal interviews with family, neighbours and boyhood friends uncover the private and less obvious side of this artist. They tell the stories of his youth, exploring characteristics of the community he came from, revealing the personal stories of the public man.

Dr. Peterson also tells his own story. Niece Sylvia Sweeney an accomplished journalist, captures the intimate recollections as only a family member could. In his five hour interview, an unguarded eloquent Dr. Peterson discusses the burdens and joys of his lifetime. He reflects on the music, the road, the artists, his family and his personal drive for recognition and perfection.

These materials do not only explore the depths of Dr. Peterson as an individual and musician, they provide evidence that he was a man of his times--surrounded by rapid social and racial change. Historical forces which built Canada, the USA and Europe are laid bare in interviews with international personalities (such as Dudley Moore, Edward Heath, and Quincy Jones). The history of blacks in Montreal is uncovered in discussions with Stanley Grizzle, Charlie Biddle and Buddy Jones. It was within the shifting winds of social and racial change that Oscar Peterson took to the stage, establishing himself as a world-class musician at a time when blacks were not welcome in many concert venues. This captivating portrait of Canada highlights the social, political and racial environment in which Dr. Peterson's musical talent emerged, driven by his personal courage and convictions.

The collected materials reflect a range of the accomplishments of this extraordinary Canadian. The comprehensive package includes extensive video and audio recordings, a 7 part radio series, a 24-track concert recording and documented research and memorabilia. The concert footage and 24-track recording are especially precious given the fact that they capture Dr. Peterson in full form prior to his stroke. These elements represent a unique multifaceted package of pertinent and valuable material.
