GOW, Jean M. (b.1903). Researcher, Author, Artist.

Jean Gow (1903-), daughter of Dr. and Mrs. David Donald, was born in Hampshire, England and emigrated to Victoria, B.C. with her family in 1910. She obtained a teacher-artist certificate from the Royal Drawing Society, London, England in 1926. She also attended the London School of Art. In 1929 she married Lt. Commander Francis R.N.R. (Peter) Gow, R.C.N. in England.

She has illustrated many publications and while stationed in Ottawa, in 1938, she wrote and illustrated a travel book, Quebec Patchwork, which was published by Macmillan. She began her career as a researcher for the C.B.C. in 1951 and retired in 1968. Presently she is writing a book on Edward, Duke of Kent, Father to Victoria, and, her autobiography.

The papers were presented in 1977 and 1981 by Mrs. Jean M. Gow.

Photographs and tape recordings have been transferred to the appropriate divisions.
