Oskar Morawetz, born in Czechoslovakia in 1917, received his early musical training in Prague, Vienna and Paris. He arrived in Canada in 1940, joined the teaching staff of the Royal Conservatory of Music in 1946, and later became Professor of Music at the University of Toronto. He obtained his Doctor of Music (U. of T.) in 1953.

He won nation-wide competitions held by the Canadian Composers Association in 1945 and 1946. Other awards include the Critics' Award at Cava dei Tirreni international composition competition in 1966; two CAPAC awards; and the Piano Concerto national competition in 1962. He was the first composer to receive a Canada Council Commission for work premiered by the Toronto Symphony Orchestra.

He has written works for full orchestra, string orchestra, piano, voice, violin, string quartet and several motion pictures. His compositions have been published by Boosey and Hawkes, Recordi and Gordon V. Thompson. A number of his works have been recorded by the International Service of the C.B.C.
