Little is known of Henry Garland (d. 1975), apart from the connection with freemasonry revealed in this collection. He appears to have lived in Hamilton, Ontario, as a young man, but later to have moved to Ottawa, where his address in 1966 was 77 Gloucester Street. He was probably an architect in the federal government's Department of Public Works.

Received in 1981 from the Archdeacon of Ottawa East, the Ven. R.P.L.F. Playfair, Rector of St. George's Anglican Church, Ottawa, through the courtesy of Mr. J.P. Francis, Anglican Diocesan Archivist of Ottawa.

Finding Aid No. 1334 supplies a chronologically arranged descriptive list of the collection.

A collection of 20 items, mainly certificates, relating to the career of Henry Garland as a freemason and architect. As indicated in Finding Aid No. 1334, two items have been transferred to the National Photography Collection, and one item is in horizontal storage.
