The Canadian Ladies' Curling Association was formed in February 1960, to promote the sport of curling for Canadian Ladies and Girls. The organization was established in order to bring together all female curlers by providing the incentive for the ten provincial ladies' curling associations to strengthen their organizations and thus improve the sport in their province.

The first Canadian President was Mrs. Hazel Watt of Ontario. In February 1976 the Yukon/Northwest Territories Ladies' Curling Association was accepted into the Canadian Ladies' Curling Association, making the eleventh entry. The founding delegates realized that it was necessary to establish an annual Canadian Ladies' Curling Championship which would serve as an attraction to hold together such an association of ten provincial associations.

The first annual National Championship for ladies was held in Ottawa, 1961. A detailed history of the Canadian Ladies Curling Association and member provinces is available in volume eleven.

Presented in 1977, 1978, 1981 and 1984 by the Canadian Ladies Curling Association.

Photographs have been transferred to the National Photography Collection, accession 1980/40.

Finding Aid No. 1188 is a file title list of the entire collection.

The collection is organized in twelve sections.

The first series contains material on General Policy including rules of play, sponsorships and public relations, 1961-1981 (volumes 1-2, 17).

The second series relates to Annual Meetings including delegates, motions and minutes, 1960-1981 (volumes 2-3, 17).

The third series deals with Executive Meetings including agendas, general manager and committee reports, 1965-1980 (volume 4).

The fourth series addresses Finances including budgets, statements, reports and ledgers, 1961-1982 (volumes 4, 17).

The fifth series pertains to Championships and includes eight sub-series: 1. Ladies; 2. Senior Ladies; 3. Junior Girls; 4. Mixed; 5. International; 6. Canada Games; 7. Silver Broom; 8. Junior Women. Includes correspondence, reports, team lists, souvenir album, and material on finances, publicity, ceremonies, trophies, and accommodations, 1960-1983 (volumes 5-8, 12, 16, 17).

The sixth series includes material pertaining to the Canadian Curling Association, Curl Canada and other curling and sports Associations, 1972-1981 (volumes 9, 17).
