FERGUSON, Alexander (1882-1978). Engineer.

Originals, 1877, 1894-1979. 2 m. Finding Aid No. 1198.

Born in Scotland in 1882, Alexander Ferguson studied engineering as an apprentice in Glasgow and as a student at the Glasgow and West of Scotland Technical College. After emigrating to Canada in 1905, he worked for the National Transcontinental Railway, District B, 1905-1914, becoming in 1910 Division Engineer in charge of construction. In 1914 he joined the Department of Railways and Canals, where he was Inspecting Engineer, 1914-1917 and General Assistant Engineer, 1918-1920. He served as Assistant Chief Engineer to the Dominion Highways Commission, 1920-1924, and from 1924 to 1927 had charge of a reorganization of the Port Colborne Government Grain Elevator. In 1927 he became Assistant General Manager for the Montreal Harbour Commission, and in 1935 was appointed Port Manager, a position he held until his retirement in 1947. After retirement he lived in Ottawa until his death in 1978.

Presented in 1979 by the Estate of Alexander Ferguson.

Maps of Montreal Harbour, the Welland Canal, Turner Valley and Ontario Highway System were transferred to the National Map Collection. Plans of houses in Ottawa, Rockcliffe and St. Hélène de Breakeyville, prefabricated houses, an arena in Ottawa, culverts and other structures were transferred to the N.M.C. A badge of the American Association of Port Authorities was transferred to the National Medal Collection, books were transferred to the Public Archives Library placed in horizontal storage, and twelve albums as well as a quantity of loose photographs documenting Ferguson's survey and construction work on the National Transcontinental Railway 1906-1911 as well as other activities were transferred to the National Photography Collection and a diploma from the Corporation of Professional Engineers of Quebec was placed in horizontal storage.

Professional career, 1904-1949. 40 cm (volumes 2-3).

Reports, memoranda, correspondence, notebooks and other material principally relating to Ferguson's employment with the National Transcontinental Railway 1905-1914, as Justice of the Peace for the District of Three Rivers 1909-1910, with the Department of Railways and Canals 1914-1920, with the Port Colborne Government Grain Elevator 1924-1927 and with the Montreal Harbour Commission 1927-1947. Arranged chronologically. The Montreal Harbour material contains a letter to Ferguson from Stephen Leacock; much of the remainder of this material consists of letters of Ferguson's investments and other personal matters.
