Born in Vancouver, John Porter served in the Canadian Army from 1941 to 1946 with intelligence duties in Britain, Italy and Northwestern Europe. He graduated from the London School of Economics in 1949 and joined the staff of Carleton University the same year. He was able to build up a solid foundation for one of Canada's best Departments of Sociology. From 1963 to 1966 he was Director of the Social Science's Division of the Faculty of Arts as well as Professor of Sociology. He served as Vice-President (Academic) of Carleton in 1977 and 1978.

He published many books and learned articles. His book <u>The Vertical Mosaic</u>, 1965, became a classic in the field of Canadian sociology. Other notable books he authored or co-authored were <u>Canadian Society</u>, 1964 and <u>Does Money Matter? Prospects for Higher Education</u>, 1973. Shortly before his death, ten essays appeared in a work known as <u>The Measure of Canadian Society</u>: <u>Education</u>, Equality, and Opportunity, 1979.

Some honours he received were his election as a Fellow of the Royal Society, the McIvor prize of the American Sociological Association and honorary degrees from McMaster and Waterloo Universities.

Presented by Mrs. John Porter of Ottawa in 1979, 1980 and 1981. Tape recordings, photographs and publications were transferred to the appropriate divisions.

Porter, John Arthur (1921-79) Sociologist

John Arthur Porter was born in Vancouver, B.C. on November 12, 1921 to Ethel and Arthur Porter, Welsh immigrants to Canada. Porter's childhood was difficult. His father abandoned the family in 1936 and Porter and the rest of the family (mother, brother, sister) were deported to England. Unable to return to school, Porter worked at a number of jobs, eventually ending up in London working as a reporter for The Daily Sketch during the early part of World War II. In 1940, at 19 years of age, he joined the Canadian Army as a private. He spent the bulk of his army years in the Intelligence Section and served in England, North Africa, Italy and Western Europe, leaving the Army as a Captain.

After the war he worked for a year for the Historical Section of the Canadian Army while attending night school in London. A lack of formal schooling meant that he had to get his London Matriculation before he could apply to the London School of Economics. He was successful and in the fall of 1946 entered the LSE. While there he took lectures from Morris Ginsberg, Harold Laski and others and worked on a student political and literary review, The Clare Market Review, to which he was an occasional contributor. Also in 1946 he married Elizabeth Stalker. The marriage was a brief one, however, as Stalker left Porter the following winter. They were divorced in 1951. Porter completed his studies in 1949, graduating with a Bachelor's degree in Economics.

In the fall of 1949, while on a trip to Canada, Porter had a meeting with a friend from the LSE who was the chairman of the political science department of Carleton College in Ottawa. He accepted the offer of a lecturer's position in the department and so began an association with Carleton that was to last thirty years.

The early years at Carleton were difficult ones but, in 1951, after teaching political science for a couple of years, he became the first appointment in sociology and proceeded to begin building the department there. At the same time, his personal life changed dramatically. He met and, in 1951, married Marion Lyons. She became a day-to-day intellectual partner for him and despite the fact she had no formal training in sociology, they eventually collaborated on a number of published works. The Porters had two children (b. 1953, 1955). In addition to his teaching responsibilities, Porter undertook a number of important publishing and research

ventures during the late 1950s and early 1960s. With three other scholars he edited Canadian Society (1961), an immensely successful introductory sociology reader which eventually went into four editions. Also, he contributed two chapters to Social Purpose for Canada, a book which was a statement of purpose for the then-nascent New Democratic Party of Canada. Most importantly, though, this was the period during which he began work on The Vertical Mosiac. He began work on it in 1952 and published parts of it in installment form in the Canadian Journal of Economics and Political Science beginning in 1955. The Vertical Mosiac was released in book form in May of 1965 and had an immediate and profound impact on the social science community in Canada. It was the first large-scale, theoreticallyinformed analysis of Canada's class structure ever written and it met with instant public and scholarly acclaim. It retains to this day a well-earned reputation as the most important book in the history of Canadian sociology. It was important because it shattered the myth that Canada was a classless society and demonstrated the overwhelming economic and political power held by a small group of elites drawn from Canada's Anglo-Saxon charter group. It earned for Porter the prestigious MacIver Award of the American Sociological Association for the best sociology book of the year in 1966 and he submitted it to the LSE for his doctoral degree (D.Sc.Econ) that same year.

Porter spent 1967-68 in Geneva as a research fellow at the International Labour Organization's Institute for Labour Studies and then, on his return to Canada, spent a year in the sociology department of the University of Toronto. He did not find the Toronto department to his liking, however, and so he returned to Carleton the following year. In 1973-74 he was Visiting Professor in Canadian Studies at Harvard University and he spent his sabbatical 1974-75 in Paris.

During the middle 1960s Porter became involved in university administration. He was Director of the Social Sciences Division of the Faculty of Arts from 1963-66, and served for a number of years on the Research Sub-committee of the Committee of Presidents of the Universities of Ontario. In 1977, he became Vice-President (Academic) of Carleton, a position from which he resigned after losing a bid for the presidency of the university in 1978. He died of a heart attack on June 15, 1979 at the age of fifty-eight.

Though best-known for **The Vertical Mosaic**, Porter was involved throughout his career in a number of major research projects most of which examined the relationships between social stratification, social mobility and education.

This research resulted in the publication of a large number of books and articles, the most important of which are: **The National Study of Occupational Prestige**(1967); **Canadian Social Structure** (1967); **Towards 2000**(1971); the Ontario High School Students' Aspirations Study [**Does Money Matter?**] (1973, 1979 published in a more scholarly version as **Stations and Callings** (1982); the National Mobility Study (published as **Ascription and Achievement** (1986); and **The Measure of Canadian Society** (1982, 1987). A complete listing of Porter's writings may be found in an appendix to the 1987 version of **The Measure of Canadian Society**, edited by W. Clement.

In recognition of Porter's achievements, he was made a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada in 1968, elected Honorary President of the Canadian Sociology and Anthropology Association in 1972, and awarded honorary degrees by McMaster University in 1973 and the University of Waterloo in 1977.
