MURRAY, Dr. Everitt George Dunne (1890-1964). Bacteriologist.

Originals, 1903-1973. 10.6 m. Finding Aid No. 949.

Born at Johannesburg, South Africa, E.G.D. Murray attended Christ's College at Cambridge University where he graduated with a B.A. in 1912, M.A. in 1918. He obtained his L.M.S.A. in 1916 at London. He served in W.W.I. as a Captain in R.A.M.C. on the research staff and in the War Office's committee on dysentery. He was published numerous articles on bacteriology and was associate editor of Bergey's Manual of Determinative Bacteriology. Dr. Murray was head of the Department of Bacteriology and Immunity at McGill University in Montreal and a visiting professor at the University of Western Ontario in London, Ontario. He also served as Bacteriologist at various other Montreal hospitals. Dr. Murray was awarded the O.B.E. in 1919 and the F.R.S.C. in 1938. He was a member of numerous associations including the International Society of Microbiologists, Canadian Public Health Association and the Society of American Bacteriologists.

Presented in 1975 and 1982 by Dr. R.G.E. Murray of London, Ontario.
