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INTRODUCTION

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In 1973, selected newspapers and other documents relating to the Lakehead area were microfilmed from the originals in the possession of the Thunder Bay Historical Museum Society, under the Local Initiative Programme. The papers are contained on 25 reels of microfilm. A copy of these reels was prepared by the Public Archives of Canada the same year.

Finding aid no. 964 lists the newspapers microfilmed and presents a brief description of the documents which include the dates, the types of documents and the names of correspondents together with the microfilm reel numbers on which the material can be located.
