INTRODUCTION

CAUCHON, Noulan (c. 1880-1935). Town Planner.

Originals, 1899-1931. 2.52 m.

Noulan Cauchon was born in Winnipeg, Manitoba, son of Joseph Edouard Cauchon, first speaker of the Senate under Confederation and later Lieutenant Governor of Manitoba. Cauchon was an early advocate of town planning in Canada and of a federal district for Ottawa. He was Chairman of the Ottawa Town Planning Commission and Supervisor of Ottawa's zoning during the 1920's. He was one of the founders of the Town Planning Institute of Canada and served as its President between 1924-1926.

Transferred in 1975 from the National Capital Commission via Rolf Latté of Heritage Unit.
