SAVAGE, Marion Creelman (1886-1975)

Marion Creelman Savage was born in Toronto and educated there at Bryn Mawr, then at Queen's College, London, Eng. and McGill University. In 1912, she married Edward Baldwin Savage, who died in 1920. She lived in Montreal most of her life and was associated with various social organizations, such as the I.O.D.E., Canadian Guild of Crafts, Local and International Council of Women, Last Post Fund and Wartime Prices and Trade Board (Women's Advisory Committee).
