Archibald Jacob Freiman (1880-1944), a Lithuanian-born immigrant, was owner and president of A.J. Freiman Ltd., a downtown Ottawa department store. An active zionist, he was president of the Zionist Organization of Canada from 1919 until his death, a member of the World Zionist Organization, President of the Adath Jeshurun Congregation, Ottawa, and chairman of the Jewish War Orphan Committee of Canada. Freiman was also involved with Canada's Diamond Jubilee Celebrations, 1927, was president of the Ottawa branch of the Retail Merchant's Association of Canada, and was Director of the Protestant Home for the Aged.

Lillian (Bilsky) Freiman (1885-1940), wife of Archibald, was born in Mattawa, Ontario. Also an active zionist, she was president of Hadassah, an executive member of the Women's International Zionist Organization, and organizer of a number of Palestine Emergency relief funds. Lillian Freiman, a holder of an O.B.E., was one of the three world representatives on the General Honorary Committee of the First General Congress for the Child. She was also involved with the Ottawa local Council of Women. She did relief work during the influenza pandemic of 1918 and worked with the League of Nations Society of Canada, 1925-1933.

Lawrence Freiman (1909-1986), son of Archibald and Lillian, was educated at McGill University and Harvard Business School and received an LLD from the University of Ottawa in 1957. Besides his position as President and General Manager of A.J. Freiman Ltd., Freiman was on a large number of Boards and executives of local, national, and international organizations, including Federal District Commission, Weizmann Institute of Science, Israel, Stratford Festival, Montreal Symplony Orchestra, National Arts Centre, Canadian Festival of the Arts, Zionist Oragnization of Canada, Canadian Welfare Council, Ottawa Philharmonic Orchestra, and the University of Ottawa.

In 1899, Archibald Jacob Freiman (1880-1944) and Moses Cramer opened the "Canadian House Furnishing Company" in downtown Ottawa, Ont. By 1902, the partnership had dissolved and Freiman and his father established "H. Freiman and Son", an enterprise which expanded its home furnishing business to include men's and women's merchandise. Freiman bought out his father's share in 1917 and by 1918 opened "The Archibald J. Freiman Department Store". The business was incorporated in 1923 as "A.J. Freiman Limited" with Freiman as president and his wife, Lillian (1885-1940), as vice-president. Their son, Lawrence (1909-), joined the business in 1931 and by 1939 had taken

), joined the business in 1931 and by 1939 had taken over as its president and general manager. Under Lawrence Freiman the business continued to expand its downtown operation but also openedup in suburban locations: Westgate Shopping Centre, 1955; Shopper's City, Blair Road (East End), Base Line Road (West End), 1966 and 1967; St. Laurent Shopping Centre, 1967. The business also expanded into North Bay, Renfrew and Pembroke, Ont., the latter being location of a Lawrence Freiman invention, "Vis-o-matic" shopping, 1950. In 1971, "A.J. Freiman Limited" was sold to the Hudson's Bay Company.
