BIOGRAPHICAL DESCRIPTION OF HARRY WALSH

Harry Walsh, whose parents were pioneer settlers in Western Canada, was born and educated in Manitoba graduating from Manitoba Law School in 1937. Sometimes known as the Perry Mason of Western Canada, he has defended over 30 persons accused of murder during his career. During World War II Mr. Walsh served as a Gunner for 2½ years with the Royal Canadian Artillery. Mr. Walsh has participated in many Jewish community activities such as the Jewish Children's Welfare Fund, Winnipeg, and the Jewish Child and Family Service, Winnipeg. He has served as President of the Winnipeg North Liberal Association and as an executive of the Manitoba Liberal Progressive Association.

Correspondence and notes relating to Mr. Walsh's personal activities and of his work with the Manitoba and Winnipeg North, Liberal Associations, 1939-1970. Speeches by Mr. Walsh and by various Liberal candidates and supporters including the Hon. E.J. McMurray, Q.C. (Solicitor-General of Canada from 1923 to 1925) and Archie Micay, Q.C. Walsh, Micay and McMurray were legal partners.

Correspondence, notes and memoranda relating to Mr. Walsh's activities in the legal community, including such topics as the Canadian Bar Conventions, the Canadian Society of Forensic Science Convention and the Jessel Club for Queen's Councillors; also included are speeches by E.J. McMurray on the Defence of Canada Regulations passed in 1939, a speech by Mr. Walsh on capital punishment; a letter from the Hon. John Turner Federal Minister of Justice, and newspaper clippings on E.J. McMurray and his role at the trial of the Winnipeg General Strikers, 1919.
