Henry Hatton Ardagh was a barrister at law and a nephew of Sir James Gowan. He was also the author of Life of Sir James Robert Gowan (Toronto, 1911). He married Marcia Fishe and had two sons, Henry Hatton Gowan Ardagh and Edward Gowan Russell Ardagh.
