SCOTT, Duncan Campbell (1862-1947). Author.

Born in Ottawa, where he lived most his life, Duncan Campbell Scott was educated in Smith's Falls, Ont. and Stanstead, Que. He began a career with the Department of Indian Affairs as a clerk in 1879, becoming Deputy Superintendent General 1913-1932. Scott published several collections of poetry and two collections of short stories, as well as writing a novel which was published posthumously. He contributed poems and prose to numerous periodicals and anthologies, and wrote a play that was produced at Hart House 1927. He collaborated with Archibald Lampman and W.W. Campbell in the Toronto Globe's literary series "At the Mermaid Inn" 1892-1893. He collaborated with E.K. Brown on a posthumous collection of Lampman's unpublished poems and prepared introductions to other collections. Scott was, at various times, a governor of the Dominion Drama Festival and the Canadian Writers' Foundation, a fellow of the Royal Society of Literature of Great Britain, and president of the Canadian Authors' Association, the Ottawa Drama League, and the Royal Society of Canada.

Letter dated 17 June 1912 from the ninth Duke of Argyll thanking Duncan Campbell Scott for pictures of the members of the Royal Society of Canada. Acquired in 1973.
