James S. Duncan was born in 1893 in Paris, France, joined Massey Harris in 1911 as an apprentice and served in the British army in W.W. I. After a period as manager of operations in Europe and South America, Mr. Duncan became, in 1936, the General Manager of Massey Harris. Named President and General Manager of the company in 1941, he became Chairman and President in 1943. Following his resignation in 1956 from Massey-Harris Ferguson, Mr. Duncan was appointed chairman of the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario, a post he held until his retirement in 1961. Mr. Duncan In 1940 he was named participated in many other activities. acting Deputy Minister for Air. He is the author of several books and made many speeches during his career. He served on various branches and trade missions, and represented Canada on international bodies. In his years of retirement he moved to Bermuda.

Presented in 1978, 1979 and 1980 by Mr. Duncan of Paget, Bermuda. Photographs have been transferred to the National Photo Collection (accession number 1979-71).
