Major-General Sir James H. MacBrien was appointed Chief of General Staff Overseas Military Forces of Canada and in 1920 Chief of General Staff, Canadian Militia. He became Chief of Staff, Department of National Defence, in 1923, and held this position until 1928. He was appointed Commissioner of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police in 1931. In 1935 he was created a K.C.B.

Volumes 1-3 were acquired in 1943 by the Army Historical Section and were later transferred to the Public Archives; volumes 4-7 were presented in 1974, 1978 and 1979 by Mrs. Lyn MacBrien Keller of Ladysmith, Quebec; vol. 8 was presented in 1981 by Mrs. Louise Grey of Ottawa, Ontario.

Correspondence, 1918-1938. Originals, 2.5 cm. Photocopies, 4 cm (volumes 1, 5).

Letters received and copies of letters sent dealing primarily with the Overseas Military Forces of Canada; letters received concerning General MacBrien's retirement from the Armed Forces and his death. Arrnged chronologically within these two series.

Subject Files, 1914-1920, 1946. Originals, 20 cm (volumes 1-3). Correspondence, reports, memoranda, statistical tables and maps. A major portion of this material concerns the Battles Committee and was intended for use in the preparation of the official war diary of the War Cabinet.

Memoranda, n.d., 1919-1928. Originals, 15.5 cm (volumes 3, 7-8).

First Series, n.d., 1919-1927. Originals, 7.5 cm (volumes 3, 7).

Memoranda relating to the organizataion of the Department of National Defence, to the Overseas Military Forces Council and to general defence policy of the 1920's. Arranged alphabetically.

Second Series, n.d., 1921-1928. Originals, 8 cm (volume 8).

Correspondence and memoranda relating to the Imperial Conference, 1926. Includes reference files on Canadian military preparedness. Arranged alphabeticaly.

Speeches, n.d. Originals, 1 cm (volume 7).

Speeches expressing MacBrien's views of defence policy in the 1920's.

Arranged alphabetically.

Clippings, 1907-1938. Originals, 10 cm (volumes 4, 6).

Certificates, 1918, 1925. Originals, 2 pages (volume 5).
Certificates marking MacBrien's induction as Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, 1918 and as Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, 1925.
