Westeel-Rosco had its roots in several nineteenth century Canadian sheet metal fabricating companies. In 1852 George Washington Reed, an American who was a slater by trade, set up the first known sheet metal company in Montreal. In 1930, he was bought out by Western Steel Products. The Metallic Roofing Company, established in 1886, manufactured metal roofing, sidings, ceilings and other architectural components. In 1899, a group of contractors formed the Roofers Supply Company in order to reduce costs by making bulk purchasers from their British and American suppliers. The immediate success of the company led to expansion in major cities throughout Canada. Considerable growth in Western Canada led to the development of several sheet metal firms which eventually merged to form Western Steel Products. In 1945, the name of the company was changed to Westeel Products Westeel Products took over Rosco (formerly the Roofers Supply Company) in 1966. A detailed history of mergers in the sheet metal industry is found in volume 3 of the collection. Both companies handled a wide range of metal products which included fire-proof doors, fire escapes, culverts, prefabricated metal buildings, farm buildings and equipment, bins, lockers, and various expanded metal products. These products were manufactured in several Canadian cities or They were installed in Canada and in countries around the imported. world. The Metallic Roofing company gained an international reputation after winning gold medals at the Paris Exhibition in 1900 and subsequent World Fairs. Their products had a major impact on architecture and methods of building as they were a durable and economical way of achieving the desired ornateness which had become prohibitively expensive in the labour intensive wood and plaster products.

Presented in 1978 by Westeel-Rosco Limited, Toronto, Ontario. An additional trade catalogue was presented in 1984 by Dana Johnson, Ottawa, Ontario.

About 100 photographs were transferred to the National Photography Collection. They include photographs of Rosco decking and siding installations across Canada and of plant interiors showing employees operating Rosco's sheet metal production machinery. For photographs of product samples for industrial exhibitions and trade fairs between 1897 and 1902 see the ledger in volume one, file six.

Finding Aid No. 1112 is a detailed file list.
