C.A.G. Matthews was a partner in the art printing firm Sampson - Matthews Ltd., established in Toronto in 1918. The firm employed a number of Canadian artists throughout its existence, including A.J. Casson, Frank Carmichael and Thoreau MacDonald, and it reproduced the work of most major Canadian artists. Matthews has been a close, personal friend of many artists and others in the art world. He is a member of the Arts and Letters Club, Toronto.
