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INTRODUCTION

In 1923 Mr. Akseli K.L. Rauanheimo, the resident Finnish Consul (later Consul General) in Montreal, initiated efforts to obtain the services of a Finnish missionary pastor in that city. After much negotiating and a visit to Helsinki, the Finnish Seamen's Mission Society (Suomen Merimies Lähetyksseura) agreed to send to Montreal as its first missionary, Pastor Frithjof J. Pennanen. Immediately following his first church service there at Easter (17 April) 1927, the worshippers decided to form a congregation of the Finnish Lutheran Church. That decision was ratified at an organizational meeting held on 22 September 1927. At this meeting a name for the group was also agreed upon: the Montrealin Suomalainen Pyhän Mikaelin Luterilainen Seurakunta (St. Michael's Finnish Lutheran Congregation of Montreal). The newly established church operated under the auspices of the Finnish Seamen's Mission Society,¹ but the congregation was ruled by its own constitution and by-laws as decided by its Annual Meetings and its elected Church Council. Pastor Pennanen received his salary from Finland; the congregation provided the space for the church services.

At a meeting on 19 May 1932, the congregation decided to incorporate itself and to join the Synod of the United Lutheran Church in America (ULCA). Previously, the Finnish Evangelical Lutheran Churches in Canada had formed part of the Suomi Synod (Hancock, Michigan), but already in 1921 the ULCA had agreed to support financially the operations of the Finnish churches in Copper Cliff (Ont.), New Finland (Sask.), and Sault Ste Marie (Ont.). By 1931, Suomi Synod was unable to contribute its share in the partnership and the ULCA took total responsibility for the financial support of Finnish Canadian Evangelical Lutheran Congregations. Besides joining the ULCA, the Finnish churches in Ontario and Quebec had to join the Canadian synod in this area, The Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Canada. In addition, ten days after the reconstitution of the church, the Finnish Conference in Canada (Suomalainen Konferenssi) was founded among the Finnish churches themselves.

The name, St. Michael's Finnish Evangelical Lutheran Congregation of Montreal (Montrealin Suomalainen Evankelis-Luterilainen Pyhän Mikaelin Seurakunta) was adopted in 1932. The church was finally

incorporated under the laws of the Province of Quebec on 29 May 1941 as St. Michael's Finnish Evangelical Lutheran Church (Pyhän Mikaelin Suomalainen Evankelis-Luterilainen Kirkko). However, the name and title of the congregation, according to its constitution and by-laws remained "St. Michael's Finnish Evangelical Lutheran Church of Montreal" ("Montrealin Pyhän Mikaelin Suomalainen Evankelis-Luterilainen Kirkko").

Pastor Pennanen resigned on 1 April 1933. His successor was Pastor Juho Yrttimaa who served for the next thirty-three years, until his death.² In 1966, Matti Terho became the pastor. In the fall of 1974, he resigned and was replaced on 1 April by Markku Suokonautio.

For its church services the congregation first used rented premises at 372-374 Lagachetière Street West. There it also operated the Finnish Immigrant Home until 1 May 1931. Then, because of financial difficulties and lessening immigration, the Home's operations were turned over to the Finnish Seamen's Mission Society. Unable to carry on, the Society was forced to close the Home altogether in the following year. Then followed a period when the church operated from various rented premises until 26 March 1941, at which time it purchased a building on 1632 Dorchester Street West. On 15 May 1960, the church moved into the building it had bought at 1500 McGregor Street (since renamed Dr. Penfield Blvd.). The church still continues to occupy these same premises.

Throughout its history, the church has played an extremely important part in the life of Montreal's Finnish community. Traditionally conservative in nature, the church has been most frequently associated with the right-wing elements in the community. Hence, the church--or, at least, part of its congregation--was usually involved in the affairs of the Montreal Finnish National Society,³ the Finnish War Veterans in Canada,⁴ the Montreal Suomi Society and the Central Organization of

Loyal Finns in Canada.⁵ The Church also lent its support to the Montreal organizers of the Finnish Aid Committee (established to help Finland during the Winter War of 1939-1940 against the USSR) and the Canada-Finland Aid Society (established to assist the recovery of post-war Finland).⁶

These records contain documentation relating to these activities as well as to the organizational matters of the church itself. Also included are the records of a religious, social and civil nature which were created as a normal part of the church's regular functions and duties. In addition, this collection also contains records and papers of a statistical and personal nature relating to the pastors and congregation of the church. In sum, the collection is a rich source for documenting the presence of the "Church Finns" in Montreal.

The collection was presented by St. Michael's Evangelical Lutheran Church in 1975, through Markku Suokonautio, the present pastor of the church.

This finding aid is a list of the file titles describing the contents of the collection. Note that this sequential listing of the file titles reflects the logical arrangement of the collection, although it was not possible to retain this order in the shelving of the files themselves. Consequently, the researcher should carefully note the volume number when requesting material or citing his source.

Volumes 1-19 are twenty-one centimetre boxes. Volume 20 is a ten centimetre box. Volume 21 is a forty-nine centimetre oversize box. Volume 22 is a fifty-five centimetre oversize box. An additional 13 cms. of index cards (3"x5") are stored in the Manuscripts "Finding Aid Card Storage System". One large poster is stored in the Manuscripts "Vertical File".
