FELLOWSHIP OF RECONCILIATION (Canada) (est. 1938)

The International Fellowship of Reconciliation was founded in England on the eve of World War I and reflected a commitment to pacifism by a group of Christian friends. The National Council of the Canadian Fellowship of Reconciliation dates from September 1938, when pacifists from every province gathered in Toronto. The Canadian Fellowship of Reconciliation is an attempt to bring together into a nation-wide fellowship all the pacifists and war-resisters who, in isolation or in small groups, are scattered across the Dominion. The Canadian branch supports a small staff engaged in educational and agitational work. It sponsors and supports various activities for peace education and action on a local, regional and national level.

Presented in 1978 and 1979 by Lillian Westell of Ottawa. Canadian publications were transferred to the Public Archives Library.
