BROWN, H. Leslie (b. 1903). Public Servant.

Originals, 1927-1977. 2 m. Finding Aid No. 862.

H. Leslie Brown was born on 31 October 1903 in London, England. He received his education in British Columbia and Alberta and joined the Department of Trade and Commerce as a Junior Trade Commissioner in 1929. During his career he served in Mexico, the United Kingdom, South Africa, Argentina, and Venezuela. From 1958 to 1963 he was Assistant Deputy Minister of the Department of Trade. In December 1963 Brown was appointed Commissioner General of the Canadian Pavilion for EXPO '67. Brown retired from government service in 1968 to become an export trade consultant for UNCTAD/GATT International Trade Centre. He worked in Jamaica and Afghanistan. He has written two manuscripts; his memoirs and a history of the Department of Industry, Trade and Commerce.

The papers were presented to the Public Archives of Canada by Mr. H.L. Brown in 1979.

Finding Aid No. 862 is a file list of the entire collection.

Trade Commissioner Series, 1929-1977. .4 m (volumes 1-3).

This series contains files relating to postings held by Brown during his service with the Department of Trade and Commerce. The files include correspondence, reports, notes, itineraries, invitations, memoranda and passports. Research material and manuscripts on the history of the Department of Trade and Commerce, and the memoirs of H.L. Brown are also included.

EXPO' 67 Series, 1958-1969. 1.6 m (volumes 3-11).

This series includes correspondence, minutes, publicity and reports relating to the planning, construction and operation of the Canadian Pavilion at EXPO '67. Scrapbooks contain material relating to the period 1965-1968. Also included in this series is the official visitors book for the Canadian Pavilion.

Note: 5 volumes of the Expo '67 General Report were transferred to the P.A.C. Library. An album of photographs and 334 individual photographs, removed from the Expo '67 scrapbooks were transferred to the National Photography Division.
