Walter L. Payne began working with the C.P.R. publicity department in London, England, in 1907. During the twenties he travelled throughout Britain presenting talks and film shows to promote travel and immigration of Britons to Canada via Canadian Pacific. In 1929 he came to Montreal to serve in the publicity department, becoming director of the motion picture and speaker's bureau in 1945. A noted international lecturer and traveller, he retired in 1956.
