Ranald MacIsaac MacDonald (1754-1859) was born at Invernesshire, Scotland. He emigrated to Canada in 1837 with his wife Janet Cameron and six children. They settled, possibly, in the Raisin River region, Glengarry County, Ontario.

Ranald's second son, John (Jock) MacIsaac MacDonald (1800-1879) emigrated to Canada from Scotland, prior to his parents, in 1831 with his wife Margaret Macdonnell (1803-1868) and their children, John I. MacIsaac and Ann (Nancy) MacIsaac MacDonald. They settled in Glengarry County where Jock worked on the farm of D.A. McDonald near Williamstown, Ontario. In 1833, Jock purchased 200 acres, Lot 29, 2nd Concession, in Kenyon Township. He later purchased Lot 24, 3rd Concession of Kenyon Township. Jock and Margaret had three more children in Canada: Donald MacIsaac, James Edmund MacIsaac and Katherine.

The collection consists of genealogical material concerning the MacIsaac MacDonald family of Glengarry County, Ontario, c.1600-1972, collected and compiled by Leroy L. Guldán over a ten year period. The material includes coats of arms, tartans, maps, birth and death certificates, records of military service, ceremonies and land transactions, membership cards, booklets and newsletters, genealogical charts, photographs, newspaper articles, correspondence, family histories and anecdotes.

Several documents are available as both originals and transcripts or photocopies.

INTRODUCTION

The file titles in this collection are, for the most part, those of Leroy L. Guldan. The order, as established by Mr. Guldan, has been maintained as far as possible.

The file titles indicate either the main subject of the file contents, or the nature of the documents contained in the file. The description which follows supplements the file title by indicating either the nature of the documents in the subject files, or the author or subject of documents in the other files. Dates and other supplementary details have been provided where they will clarify the file titles.

A number of photographs has been transferred to the National Photography Collection under the accession number 1982-126.
