A miner at the Froid Open Pit, Norman Jaques served on the executive of Local 598, International Union of Mine, Mill and Smelter Workers from 1949 to 1959, mainly as financial secretary. The local which consisted of the employees of the International Nickel Company of Canada, was organized in 1942 and certified in 1944. Both Mine-Mill as a whole and Local 598 were fraught by intense political factionalism. In 1967, after years of jurisdictional fighting, the Union merged with the United Steelworkers of America. Falconbridge workers opposed this move and remained as an independent union, Mine, Mill and Smelter Workers Local 598.
