Lt.-Col. Gordon G.K. Holder went overseas as a private in 1916, and served with the 26th Battalion in France from June 1917 to August 1918. He was discharged as a Lieutenant on his return to Canada, and served between the wars as a Militia officer. During World War II he commanded No. 7 District Depot in New Brunswick.

Presented in 1973, 1974 and 1975 by the 26th Battalion Association and Lt.-Col. G.G.K. Holder through S.D. MacGowan of St. Catharines, Ontario.

Finding Aid No. 893 is a list of file titles arranged by subject.

Records of the 26th Battalion, Canadian Expeditionary Force, retained by the Unit on its return to Canada, including pay books and individual correspondence, correspondence on the Battalion Association and daily orders, field returns, a nominal roll of original officers and men and of reinforcements, a roll of men in prison in France, and memoranda concerning the London March Past in May 1919.
