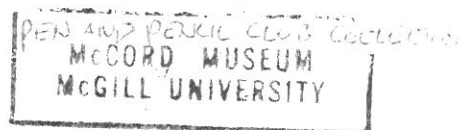

Born in Winnipeg, Charles Clay taught at Indian Reserve schools in Northern Manitoba and was an United missionary during the 1920's. His Swampy Cree legends was published in 1938. In 1931 Clay became the literary editor of the Winnipeg Free Press. Later he edited the Canadian Author and Bookman, a Canadian Authors' Association publication and Fire Fighting in Canada. He contributed articles to Encyclopaedia Britannica and Grolier's Book of Knowledge Annual. Clay was an active member of the Canadian Authors' Association, the Canadian Writers' Foundation, The League of Nations Society and the Canadian Institute of International Affairs.

Presented in 1941 to 1968 by Charles Clay and transferred in 1971 from the National Library. Photographs have been transferred to the National Photography Collection.
