Until about 1963 this organization was called Morning Music Club (founded 1892); then it became the Pro Musica Society which in turn changed its name to Concert Society of Ottawa sometime between April and July of 1969. The Society was disbanded in 1974. The papers were deposited at the National Library by Miss Prichard acting on behalf of the directors.
