PEAKER, Charles

Originals 1912-1975 & n.d.

One of Canada's outstanding concert organists, Charles Peaker was born in Derby, England in 1899. When thirteen years old, his family emigrated to Canada, settling in Saskatoon. In 1919 he was awarded a Heintzman scholarship to study in Toronto with Willan, MacMillan, and Seitz. During his various studies he was awarded the A.T.C.M. (1919); B.Mus (1925) and D.Mus. (1936), University of Toronto; and was granted the F.R.C.O. (1929).

Peaker began his performing career as a theatre organist. However, from the mid 1920's he worked almost exclusively as a church musician. Although his first appointment was in St. Paul Street United Church, St. Catharine's, Ontario (1926-1928), Peaker spent the duration of his career attached to Toronto churches: Rosedale United, 1930-36; Deer Park United, 1937-44; and finally, St. Paul's Anglican, Bloor Street, 1944-75. Peaker was in great demand as a recitalist, making tours not only of Canada, but of the United States of America (1935), and Great Britain (1954).

Although mainly interested in being a practising organist, Peaker had many teaching positions, including at the Royal Conservatory of Music of Toronto (1930-1970, serving as Director 1944-45); and lecturer, University of Toronto (1952-65). Peaker made large contributions to the University's musical life by conducting the Hart House Glee Club (1934-50) and as University Organist (1952-65).

A man of catholic tastes, Peaker was an ardent student of literature, particularly Shakespeare, writing and lecturing on the subject. Occasionally, he applied his critical talents to music, sometimes to subjects with which one does not normally associate a church organist: reviewing the rock opera Jesus Christ Superstar, and a performance given by Elvis Presley.

Although plagued for many years with a heart condition, Peaker maintained a sincere interest in many organizations: Ontario Registered Music Teacher's Association, serving as President 1948-49; Royal Canadian College of Organists, serving as President, 1941-43, and as Hohorary President from 1974 until his death; and Honorary Life Member of the Royal Canadian Institute. He was appointed a Member of the Order of Canada in 1974.

The collection consists mainly of concert programmes, clippings by and about Charles Peaker, radioscripts, and several miscellaneous items.

The following concert programmes have Victoria, B.C., June 16, 1962; First Presbyterian Church, Chatham, Ont., May 12, 1970; St. Paul's Church, Toronto, April 15, 1960; July 14, 1960; March 31, 1961. As well, 2 photographs of an organ console in Akron, Ohio have been transferred to the Photo Collection: Nos. 0000-185 and 0000-186.
