Access conditions - Conditions de consultation

The Harry Sutherland fonds is comprised of records of several different accessions, with Access Conditions previously fixed. This document summarizes the access conditions for each accession along with their bring-forward dates. In addition, Access Conditions for the newly processed accrual (BAN No. 2000-01193) have been set out here.

The records in the new accrual of the Harry Sutherland fonds were assessed for access concerns in regards to the recommendations in the Library and Archives Canada document Establishing and Managing Intellectual Access Conditions for Private Fonds and Archival Collections, which provides guidelines for access restrictions to private records in the Library and Archives Canada collection. These guidelines are based on four considerations: the privacy expectations of persons or organizations whose information is contained in a file, the level of sensitivity of information contained in a file, the foreseeable likelihood of harm should sensitive information be released and the context of the file. Bring forward dates to open or to open with restrictions the closed files of the fonds have been established based on the mostrecent documents in the file in conjunction with Branch resources to review these files.

Access Conditions Exemptions: Closed records in the Harry Sutherland fonds may be consulted by a researcher duly approved by the Historian and Archivist of the Vincent Graves Green Philatelic Research Foundation. Any closed record in the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada series of the fonds and its sub-series may be consulted by a researcher duly approved by the Historian and Archivist of the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada. The researcher is responsible for securing approvals
