RG 14, volume 2250 contains:

- A bound ledger titled "Establishment Record of the House of Commons" that includes a nominal Index of employees followed by entries for each member of the establishment providing name / date of birth / date of appointment / salary / remarks. The first entry is John G. Bourinot (Clerk). The entries are not in date of appointment order, so the Index is critical for finding people.
- A second bound ledger titled "Establishment Record of the House of Commons, volume II." This ledger book also includes a nominal Index and, again, the entries are not in strict date of appointment order. Entries cover appointments for the years *circa*. 1916-41.
- A bound ledger titled "Register - House of Commons" and bearing inside entries under the heading "List of Employees, House of Commons." Information provided includes: name / age on 1 July 1882 / 1st appointment and date / promotions and dates / present rank / religion / nationality / Province /salary on 1 July 1882.
- A bound register titled "Oaths of Allegiance, House of Commons" that includes oaths taken for allegiance to His Majesty King Edward VII and H.M. King George V.
- A file titled "List of Employees, Staff Matters" that contains miscellaneous memoranda, index cards and lists of House staff for a range of dates.
- A file titled "Establishment Book - H of C, 1911" that is a bound ledger recording the establishment within the Sergeant-at-Arms Department of the Commons .
- A file titled "Correspondence, Memos, etc., 1888-1920" that contains just that - a miscellany of form letters, memos, letters, lists, etc.
- A file titled "Paylists, 1903-1919" that contains various paylists for positions such as clerks, charwomen, pages and messengers.
