### Biographical sketch

Gauntlet Press, founded in 1960, is the personal press of poet Richard Outram and his artist wife Barbara Howard. The press publishes his poetry illustrated by her wood engravings. The earliest productions were broadsides and cards, but books of poetry have also been issued, including Thresholds (1973), Locus (1974), Arbor (1976). These carefully crafted editions are printed on handmade paper and bound by the Outrams themselves. Richard Outram was born in Oshawa in 1930. He is an employee of the CBC, and has been writing poetry since the 1950's. Outram has also published collections of poetry with other publishers such as Exultate, Jubilate (Toronto: Macmillan, 1966), The promise of light (Toronto: Anson-Cartwright Editions, 1979), Selected poems (Toronto: Exile Editions, 1984) and Man in love (Erin, Ont.: Porcupine's Quill, 1985).

### Scope and content

Manuscripts and typescripts of Outram's poetry and prose, 1958-1985; drawings, proofs and woodblocks by Barbara Howard; mock-ups of many of the Gauntlet Press publications.

Note:

Researchers should consult the inventory that was prepared by R. Outram. It contains detailed information on the creation of these Archives. We have tried to respect as much as possible the original order. A copy of the inventory is in Box 1, file 25.

Verse and prose. The verse consists of four poems; ELEMENTAL, MORTAL COMBAT, NO, and PULSE, a total of 32 lines, and there are no work sheets for these. "It was written in January 1978 in the hope or expectation of reading it at the Memorial Service at Massey College for Allan Fleming; in the event, I was not asked to participate. It is unpublished (although two of the poems, ELEMENTAL and PULSE have been published), although a number of copies have been given to friends. I consider it to be a work of importance, at least to me". Total of 54 pages.
