The first built by 2 Cdn Corps Tps Engrs and named 'YARDLEY', was a low level normal Bailey pontoon bidge 610 feet long, not designed to operate throughout the full range of water levels.

The second, 'QUEBEC', was designed and built by 15 GHQ Tps Engrs to remain open throughout the probable range of water levels (20'). The bridge is believed to be one of the longest Baileys in existence, the total length being 1240' across the winter bed. Approx. 200 men worked on the site for ten days, assembling 515 tons of eqpt in freezing weather to open the bridge on the day for which it was asked.
