Accompanied by Cdn and Belgian offrs, Hon. W.F.A. Turgeon, Cdn Ambassador to Belgium, this morning placed a wreath on the tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Brussels. A guard of honor, composed of Cdn Inf Corps members, was drawn up before the tomb and, prior to the placing of the wreath, the Canadian Ambassador inspected the soldiers. He was accompanied by COL. C.J. LAURIN, Col i/c Adm., Cdn Section, 1st Echelon; LT.COL. C.P. HEBERT, Brussels Garrison; GEN GERARD, chief of the Belgian Mission, and Mr. PIERRE DUFUY, Charge d'Affairs in the Cdn Legation. The guard was in charge of CAPT. R.R.Z. ROULEAU.
