The following picture was taken at the request of MAJ. McDOUGALL for MR. MARSHALL of the CBC, showing a captured high-speed recorder. I have no technical data on this machine, but briefly it records high speed transmission, either voice or morse, on a tape. Afterwards this tape can be played back through the recorder and an operator can adjust its speed so that he can copy the transcription. It was used, I understand, by the Nazis to record telephone conversations.
