- 49631 - The Germans blew the bidge across the Overlisselsch Canal but our trps were not hel up long here for the civilians towed a ferry down the river to the rd crossing and ferried the light vehs across.
- 49632 - Veh being ferried across canal - demolished bidge in background.
- 49633 - The blown bidge. Engrs are already at work preparing the bidge for a bridging operation while at the same time our Infantry make their way across the ruins of the old bidge.
- 49634 - Infantry moving across blown bridge.
- 49635 - Just below the town of Lemle the civilians rounded up two Jerries and the whole town of Lemle, men, women and children, escorted the two P.O.W to our lines. Here we see them marching down the rd, the two Jerries in the front rank and not looking very happy.
- 49636 - An American Offr is liberated. LT. RICHARD C. VOGEL, of West Seneca, N.Y. (shot down over Holland seven months previously) is shown talking to the people who hid and sheltered him for thi period. Left to right: MR. JOHN VAN DER MEYE, Lemelerveld; Mrs. S.C.
