The women in this camp numbered 1700 and were taken prisoner in Warsaw, Poland, in Sep 44 in the Polish uprising in that city against the Germans. It came at the time of the Russian advance on that city. Help from the Russian Army came too late and after those women had been taken prisoner. They surrendered as regular Polish Army women and were treated as prisoners of war as laid down in the Geneva convention. No Polish Div operating in the 1st Gdn Army overran the camp in their advance northwards.

About 750 were included in the first batch, and after coming from Holland by train, they were sent on to the U.K. by air. Each man carried his own personal kit for the trip. Practically every unit in the Cdn army was represented in this first draft. Main topics of conversation concerned reminiscences of the fighting in Normandy, plans for the future in Canada, and the fact that they had to ride in a P.O.W. train from Nijmegen to Brussels.

The full repatriation scheme of 5yr old Cdn trps started on its way on 31 May 45 with approximately 3,000 trps arriving at 4th Bn, 2 CDR Gp, Nijmegen.

Approx. 1,000 men will sail across the English channel for England and 4,000 will fly from Brussel to England from where they will sail for Canada.
