The women in this camp numbered 1700 and were taken prisoner in Warsaw, Poland, in Sep 44 in the Polish uprising in that city against the Germans. It came at the time of the Russian advance on that city. Help from the Russian Army came too late and after those women had been taken prisoner. They surrendered as regular Polish Army women and were treated as prisoners of war as laid down in the Geneva convention. The Polish Div operating in the 1st Can Army overrun the camp in their advance northwards.
