

## REMEMBRANCE DAY ON H.M.C.S. WARRIOR

Canada's first aircraft carrier punctuates its intensive training cruise with the observance of Remembrance Day in the Caribbean. Members of H.M.C.S. WARRIOR'S thousand man crew mark the two-minute silence on November 10th while the ship passes close to island of Haiti on its voyage to the Canadian west coast from Halifax. On board H.M.C.S. HUOTKA, Warrior's Atlantic escort destroyer, a similar service was in progress.
