Royal Commission on Broadcasting, 1955-1957

The Royal Commission on Broadcasting was appointed by an Order in Council of 2 December 1955. The commissioners were Robert M. Fowler, chairman, Edmond Turcotte and James Stewart. Paul Pelletier was the secretary. Public hearings were held in twelve principal cities during the periods 30 April 1956 - 29 June 1956 and 10 September 1956 - 12 October 1956. The report of the Royal Commission was published in March 1957. The papers of the Commission were transferred to the Public Archives in April 1957.
